



# QUICK GUIDE TO USING APPLE TV

APPS, CHANNELS AND GETTING AROUND APPLE TV

## GETTING STARTED

Want to watch your favourite Aussie TV channels or login to your Netflix account?

That's cool, open any of the pre-installed apps on your TV, login (if required) using your personal account and enjoy your content. If you would like to customise your Apple TV further by installing your own apps and games or syncing across your photos, you will need an Apple ID.

If you are already using an Apple product, you can use your current Apple ID.

### DON'T HAVE AN APPLE ID?

Simply head over to the Apple website and create your Apple ID there. Once created, use your Apple ID details to login to the App Store. Check page 4 for more info on installing apps.

Note: For shared apartments, as the Apple TV is in a common area, be sure to log out of your accounts after use to ensure nobody accidentally buys anything on your account.

### SUBSCRIPTIONS

While we have pre-installed some apps for your convenience, you will need to login with your own accounts where the app requests you to sign-up (for example, on Netflix or Spotify). Iglu does not pay for any of your subscriptions.

### KEEP YOUR ACCOUNT TO YOURSELF

You can personalise the Apple TV to suit your preferences when logged into your iCloud account. Whilst logged in, your settings will remain in place.

If you are staying in a **shared apartment**, remember that it is a shared Apple TV so **sign out of your account after** using to avoid having any unauthorised downloads or purchases on your account.

When the time comes for us to part ways, be sure to **sign out and delete your login information** from the Apple TV before you leave.

## GETTING APPY

### APPLE TV APPS AND CHANNELS

To access Australian Free to Air channels, you will need to use their respective channel app. You can find a list of these below.

You will also find some app exclusive channels that aren't broadcast on regular digital TVs. The TV networks are always adding new channels to their apps, so be sure to check them out regularly to see if there's anything new.

Many other countries also have free apps available which will allow you to stream content from their TV networks as well. Have a look online and be sure to let your friends know if you find any you think they may like.

## A FEW QUICK BASICS

### HOW TO OPEN AN APP

Using the Siri Remote, navigate to an app on the Apple TV Home screen, then press the Touch surface to open it. Press and hold the Menu button to return to the Home Screen.

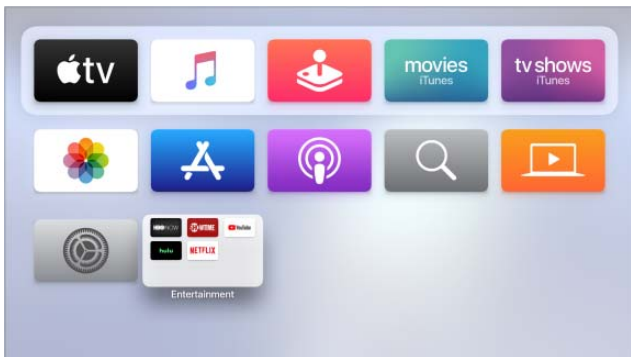
### DOWNLOADING APPS

In the App Store on Apple TV, highlight Buy or Get (for a free app), then press the Touch surface of the Siri Remote to begin downloading.

### DELETING AN APP

1. Use the Touch surface on the Siri Remote to select the app you want to delete, then press and hold until the app starts to jiggle.
2. Press the Play/Pause button Play/Pause button for more options, then delete.

### CUSTOMISE YOUR HOME SCREEN



You can change the order of apps on the Home screen and place your favourite apps in the top row. When you highlight an app in the top row, you get shortcuts that can take you to content without opening the app first.

On the Home screen, you can also delete apps from the App Store that you no longer use and change the appearance of backgrounds and menus between light and dark.

## USING THE SIRI REMOTE

Navigate using the touch surface and buttons on the Siri Remote to select and open apps and content on Apple TV.



## USING THE TRACK PAD

- Swiping on the Siri Remote trackpad will allow you to scroll around the screen, fast forward and rewind through movies music.
- Rest your thumb on the trackpad
- Lightly swipe your thumb up, down, left, or right to scroll on the Apple TV.
- Start from the far edge of the trackpad and swipe your thumb toward the other side to scroll quickly through a lot of stuff.

## APPLE TV / HOME BUTTON

The Apple TV button is a shortcut to the TV app; however, you can change this to function as a Home button.

- Press the TV button once to jump to Up Next in the TV app from anywhere.
- Press the TV button again to go to the Home screen.
- Double-press the TV button to see your recently used apps in Multitasking
